

Accepting, Downloading, and Sharing Your IRMI Certification Digital Badge



Overview: This document provides step-by-step instructions on how to do the following*:

- Accept Your IRMI Certification Digital Badge
- Set up your Credly log in
- Log into your Credly account
- Change your Badge Settings
- Download your badge
- Share your badge on LinkedIn, Facebook, and Twitter

*Images in this document display the Energy Risk and Insurance Specialist (ERIS®) badge. However, these instructions will work for all IRMI certifications.

As an active certification holder, you will receive an email from “International Risk Management Institute, Inc. via Credly” inviting you to claim your digital badge. Please allow up to 4 weeks after you complete your final core course for your email to arrive.

1. After completing your final core course, you will receive an email from “International Risk Management Institute, Inc. via Credly” inviting you to accept your badge. It may take up to 4 weeks after you complete your certification for your email to arrive. The email you receive will look like the example shown below.

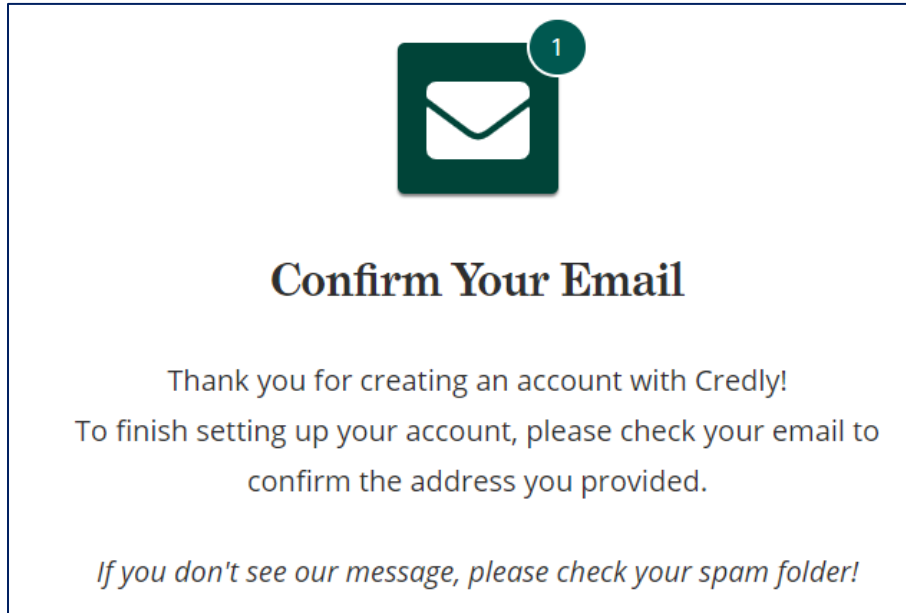

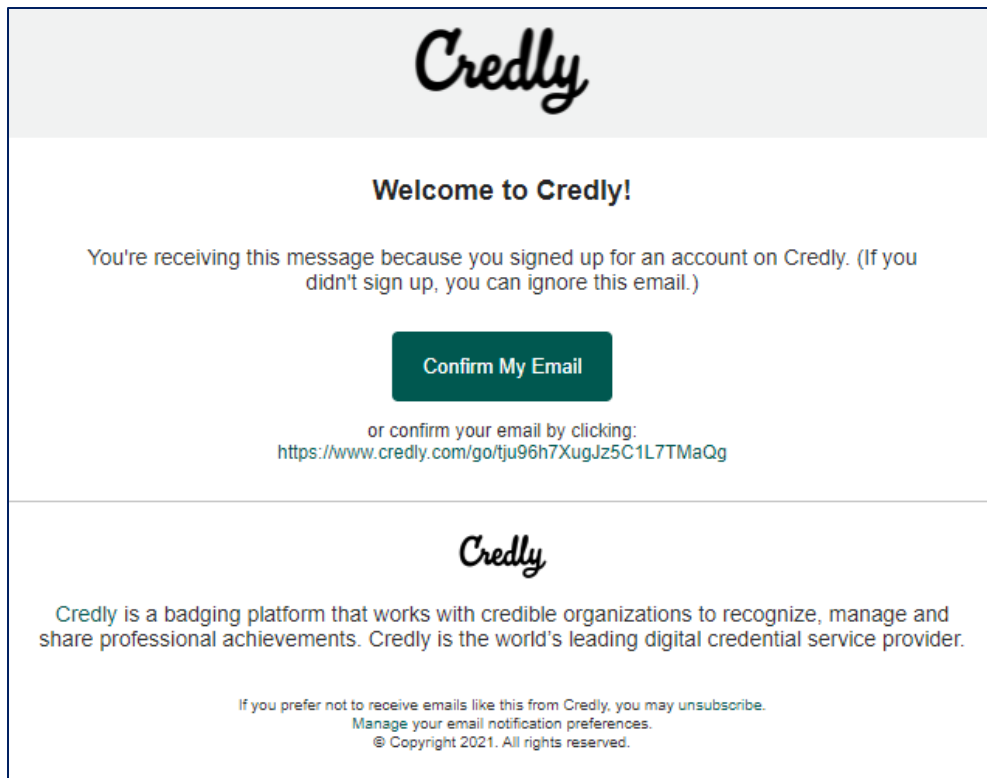

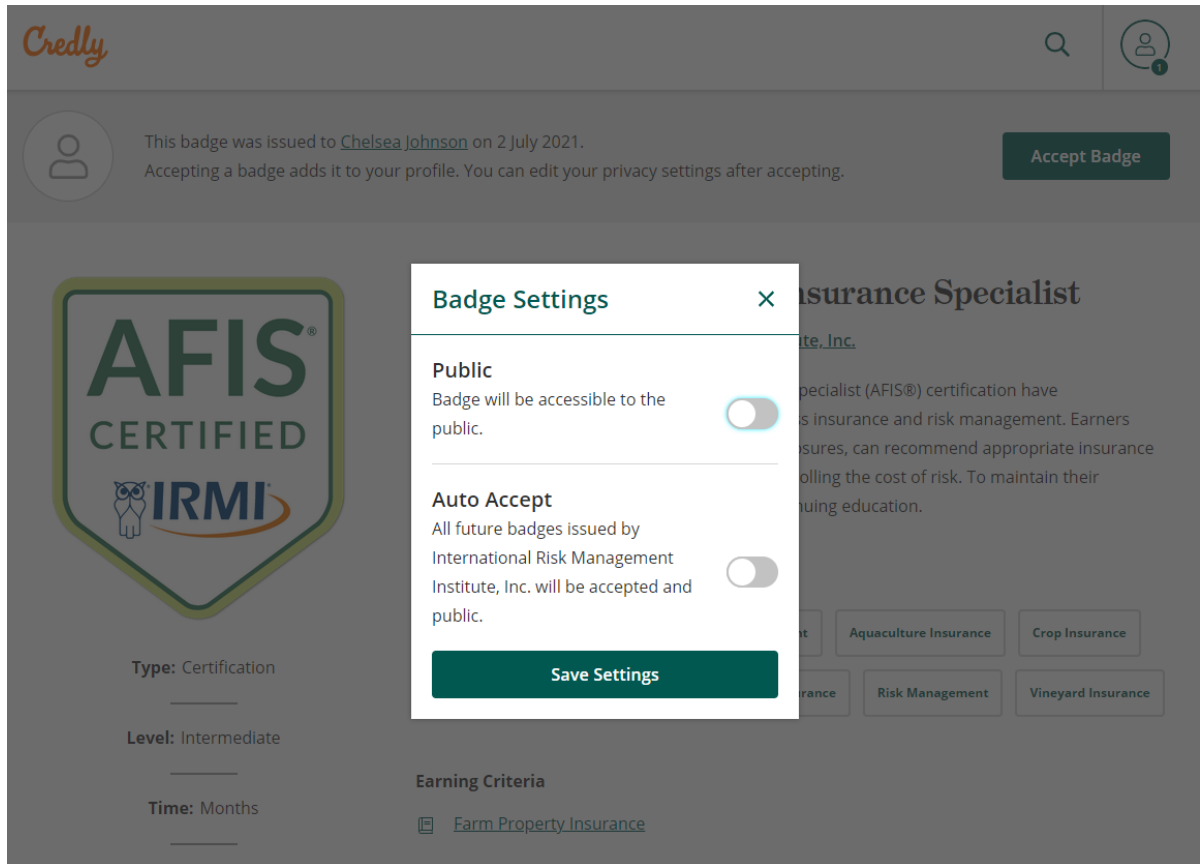

6. After accepting your badge, a “Badge Settings” window will pop up on your screen. Your badge must be made public to share or download your badge. To change these settings, drag (or click) on the gray “Public” toggle to turn the public setting on. You also have the option to “Auto Accept” all future badges.


